This theatrical art form, which integrates dance, ritual, music, and intricate costumes, is regarded as a symbol of the spiritual and value systems of the Kingdom of Thailand

For this special workshop, you'll be given a presentation on the subject of the wonderful Khon Masks by our esteemed volunteer, Ms Tetiana Zbryzka, followed by the 18 Coronets Mask Painting workshop, where you'll get to create your own piece of art, which is a face-mask of the monkey warriors in the story of Ramakien.

The workshop will be led by a Poh Chang Academy alumnus and an awarded Art Educator at Kanchanapisek Non-formal Education Centre who specialises in crafting traditional Thai arts including Khon Masks: Khru Kalayakorn Akarayakul.
